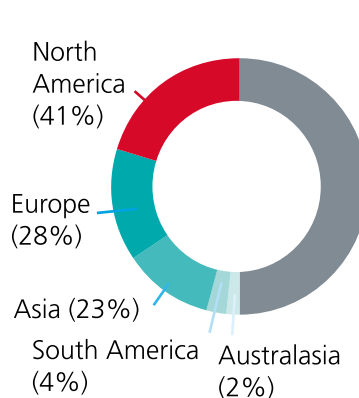

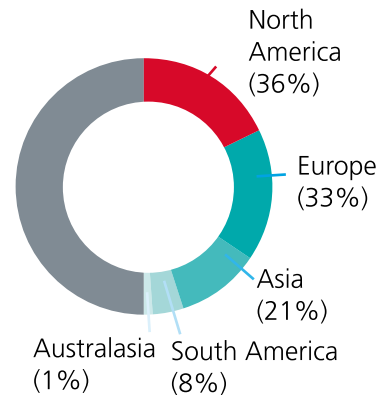

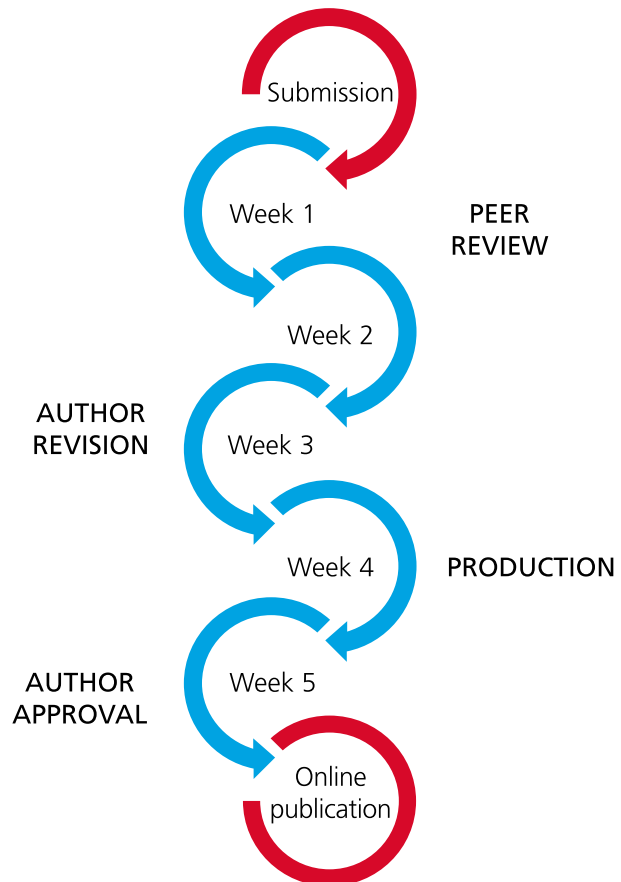
## ACCELERATED PUBLICATION

Your paper will publish in 14 to 16 weeks as standard (pending successful peer review).

But if you require a faster service, you can publish in as little as 6 weeks through our Accelerated Publication service.

A fee of £180/\$300/€225 per published page applies, and publication is, of course, still subject to approval by independent peer review.

Open Access is only available to authors for non-commercial use. Sponsors or third-parties wishing to make an article free to download from our website can provide access by paying the appropriate free access fee. More information on the free access option is available upon request.

### SOCIAL MEDIA
